It is essential that all workplaces utilizing forklifts have the checklist below or one equivalent on the premises. If all of the safety rules are being followed, each of these questions should be answered with a "yes". A "no" to whichever question indicates a procedural flaw which could cause injury, damage to machinery or accident.

- 1) Is the traffic of the pedestrians separate from the operating are of the forklift?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to travel areas of the forklift restricted by barriers?
- 3) Are pedestrian walkways well marked and provided?
- 4) Are "forklift in operation" signs visibly clear?
- 5) Are mirrors for drivers and pedestrians provided at blind spots?
- 6) Changes or alterations to the daily forklift schedule has been communicated to staff?
- 7) Are forklift tires suitable for utilization on all operating surfaces?
- 8) Lift truck seatbelt is being utilized?
- 9) The seat of the forklift is in good condition?
- 10) Is a regular forklift maintenance schedule followed?
- 11) Are yearly checks of the forklift being done?
- 12) Is the forklift right for the needed tasks?
- 13) Is there a load chart that is readable on the forklift?
- 14) Could the operators understand and read the load chart?
- 15) Does the chart list the safe capacity for various attachments and uses?
- 16) Do the forklift warning devices work properly?
- 17) The speed operating control device is secured right?
- 18) Is overhead cage fitted properly on the lift truck?
- 19) Have all forklift operators obtained certification?
- 20) Speed limits and warning signs are being observed?
- 21) The operators have current training for the forklifts being used?
- 22) Do operators know their duties to report any machine damage and forklift incidents?
- 23) Is the pre-test checklist reviewed each day prior to the equipment being operated?
