A crane operator for example must undergo an in-depth training course that cover various certification programs before being able to operate an overhead crane. Several heavy machinery truck drivers however could only require some other site specific training as well as their CDL. The in-depth training which follows certain equipment is required because much of the work takes place in hazardous scenarios and hazardous scenes so the operator must be able to make sure of a safe working surroundings at all times. The safety training is very important along with the communications training that helps the group on the ground be able to always communicate with the operator.

Because of the extreme environments these machinery work under, they are often put under incredible strain on a regular basis. This means there are a lot of heavy machinery jobs available for the repair and maintenance of the machines. Operators of heavy machines are really trained workers who can troubleshoot, repair and diagnose heavy machines on site or in a workshop. Mechanics must be available to transport their tools to a job site and carry out repair and maintenance in different conditions.

It could be possible for delivery drivers to get work with just a CDL, though for some jobs, specific endorsements might be required. Like for instance, delivering huge pieces of machinery or components which are exceptionally big for construction projects will need the driver to complete further training in order to handle and haul oversize loads. Normally, the drivers operate along with chaperone vehicles which are driven by trained drivers. These chaperone vehicles normally escort the delivery truck to its destination.
