Introduction

General Hazards

Common types of hazard in a warehouse environment are slips, trips and falls. These accidents are often caused when employees lose their balance or stumble over something which has not been put away properly. Removing or placing stuff from storage can result in a slip or fumble, possibly resulting in both worker and item to fall. The potential for trips, falls and slips is increased when employees are moving things on different kinds of floor surfaces and on different levels. One more common danger is getting hit by falling stuff. This is usually caused by failure to properly stack things on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries because of improper lifting methods are another common hazard.

There are inherent risks in utilizing and working around workplace machinery. Accidents could often be caused from the incorrect utilization of forklift trucks, conveyors and hand trucks. Warehouse tools, such as pallets, skids, cutting and strapping tools, must be utilized cautiously in unpacking, packing and loading.

Materials that are hazardous, combustible or flammable present one more type of workplace hazard while being stored inside a warehouse. Employees need to know how to take steps to protect themselves from health hazards while working around hazardous materials.
